Safety Corner – Hot Topics for Host Safety

Weekly Safety Topic: Coyotes

You've likely noticed an increased coyote presence around the Resort. Unfortunately, this is because they are not as scared of humans or cars as they should be. If they become a nuisance (and one instance of a coyote following a woman to a car), they'll have to be euthanized.

Ways to Keep Them Wild:

- Secure Food and Trash-Ensure dumpsters are locked, and litter is picked up in your areas.
- Keep a Safe Distance-NEVER approach a coyote or attempt to coax them towards you.
- Scare Them-If you see them on the road or in heavily trafficked areas honk your horn, wave your arms, yell... keep a safe distance and remind them that humans are weird and scary.
- Educate our Guests- Coyotes, while friend-shaped are not friendly. Feeding them is illegal and decreases their fear of humans.
